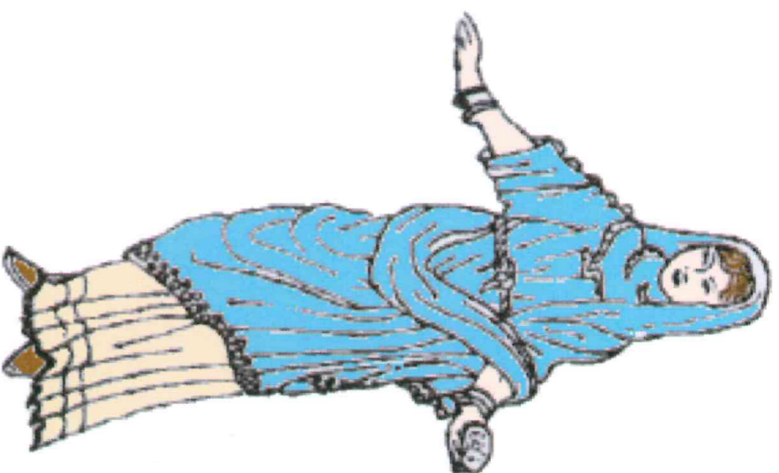


Roman girls wore a tunic and a stola, a dress belted at the waist.
